

Co-President:

The Co-President is a member of the Executive Committee who is a leader of the POPS organization and acts as the liaison to the Director of the Performing Arts.

Key Responsibilities include: providing strategic leadership for POPS by working with the Board to establish an organizational vision with long-range goals, enhancing and/or developing, implementing and enforcing policies and procedures of the organization by way of systems that will improve the overall operation and effectiveness of POPS, along with the treasurer, is involved in planning, developing, implementing, directing and evaluating organization's fiscal function and performance, recruiting new board members whose vision align with the mission, encouraging, advising and assisting other board members as they carry out their roles, presiding over meetings of the Executive Committee and the four General POPS meetings throughout the year, setting the date, place and agenda, representing the organization at performances, meetings and activities in the community and overseeing the POPS Grant process. It is also the job of a co-president to communicate regularly with the Director of

Performing Arts to ascertain how POPS can best support the WPS Performing Arts staff, students and programs.

This job is for someone who ready to sit in the director's chair but knows that they have a supportive cast and crew.
